SUPPLEMENTAL MILK CAN HELP YOU GET MORE MILK OUT OF YOUR SOWS

Today's producers have invested a lot in their genetics and they'd like to get as much out of them as they possibly can. They've selected sows with excellent milking ability, larger litter sizes and high teat numbers, as well as structural soundness.

FOSTERING PIGS OFF CAN LIMIT MILK PRODUCTION

However, for a number of reasons, there continues to be a variation in how much milk each teat will produce. Many pigs, if they happen to be on a teat that provides less than a full meal, will either end up having to be fostered off, or they'll starve-out. So it's not

uncommon to have between one and three pigs transferred off each sow to maintain an acceptable pre-weaning mortality.

Because of this reality, the milk production of the sows is limited, and a percentage of potential milk production is forfeited, when fewer pigs are left to nurse the sow. How many dairy farmers would leave the teat cup off and give up this milk production, just because the teat is not producing a "full meal"?

ECONOMICALLY EFFECTIVE PRODUCTION TOOL

A proven supplemental milk-feeding program will assist you in keeping more pigs nursing your sows, thereby helping you get more milk out of your genetic investment.
